The past year was one which saw significant improvements in the areas of growth, volunteer development, operational excellence, and overall quality as outlined in Pi Kappa Alpha's 2007-2012 Strategic Plan. The 2007-2008 year was the first full fiscal year where the goals and objectives of this plan could be seen as the driving forces behind the work of Pi Kappa Alpha's chapters, volunteers, international officers, and staff.

In the area of growth, Pi Kappa Alpha saw its second consecutive year of impressive growth with over a 5% increase, resulting in its second largest undergraduate membership base of all time. Several impressive charterings added to the growth of the overall organization. With the ongoing efforts of our chapters, existing colonies and future expansion sites, growth continues to be at the forefront for PKA.

Organizational efficiency was the goal behind achieving operational excellence for Pi Kappa Alpha. The goals and objectives in the Strategic Plan continue to be articulated amongst all arms of the Fraternity for their comprehensive implementation. The addition of new programs and technology has aided in the financial management of both chapters and the International Fraternity, all while allowing

us to maintain a competitive pricing structure within the fraternal industry. Our insurance and self-retention program continues to be the envy of our competition.

Volunteer Development continues to be a focus area for the Fraternity with exclusive staff resources recently being dedicated to this area. As has long been Pi Kappa Alpha's understanding, those chapters with the best and most tenured volunteers are often our perennial best chapters. A great deal of research has been conducted in this area with new resources and programs planned for implementation in 2008-2009.

Quality amongst our individual members and chapters is also at an all time high with more men participating in Pike University educational programs than ever before. Improved benchmarking for our chapters now allows them to better gauge where they stand relative to their peers. The mission of building a greater number of excellent chapters will continue to set the agenda for Pi Kappa Alpha in the future.

Pi Kappa Alpha's leadership programming offered through Pike University concluded its fifth year shattering previous attendance records with more than 2,300 undergraduates from over 180 chapters and colonies participating in at least one event. In February, 389 attendees at the Chicago Leadership Summit represented the largest leadership summit to date! The overall 2007-08 event attendance reflects an almost 8% increase over the previous year's attendance.

The year began with the biennial Academy in Olive Branch, Mississippi, where more than 300 student leaders from over 117 chapters participated in various sessions from chapter programming tactics to personalized leadership concepts and principles. The Fraternity also recognized the accomplishments of individuals and chapters through its annual international awards program.

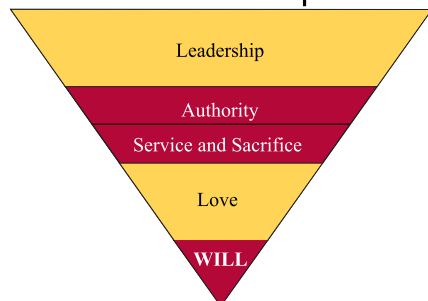

The International Educational and Recruitment Advisors are very excited about this addition to the Pike University curriculum.

## Chapter Services

The International Fraternity's services department is charged with providing Pi Kappa Alpha's chapters with specific developmental support throughout the academic year. This support includes annual consultant visits as well as specialized visits for developmental and recruitment purposes. 2007-2008 brought many successes to Pi Kappa Alpha. Seven chapter consultants began traveling in early August to targeted chapters for over 30 recruitment visits. These visits educated chapters on appropriate strategies and prepared them for a successful year in their membership recruiting efforts. Standard consultant visits commenced shortly thereafter to provide all 215 chapters and colonies with chapter programming recommendations in membership education, financial and real estate management, risk awareness, alumni relations, recruitment, and a continued

emphasis on effective chapter management. To address the fraternity's rapid growth from a staffing perspective, two additional consultants were hired mid-year to continue moving in a positive direction. The Fraternity is proud to announce ten consultants will be traveling to all chapters and colonies throughout the 2008-2009 school term.

The services department is also charged with aiding chapters as they handle situations that demand more attention from the International Fraternity. Many of these developmental visits focus on addressing behavioral concerns and mediating disputes with universities.

All chapters and alumni are encouraged to contact the services department to request any assistance in areas of chapter management and operations. Your chapter consultant can also provide the support needed in these areas.

## Chapter Finances

2007-08 proved to be a historic year in terms of chapter finances. A number of chapters that have been indebted to the International Fraternity for as many as five years took hold of their destiny and eliminated their outstanding balance. As a result, the Fraternity's chapter accounts receivable is at a 20-year low, and more chapters were eligible to vote at the 2008 International Convention than have been in a very long time.

Additional improvements in the area of chapter finances include a continuously-improving standard budget utilized by the majority of Pi Kappa Alpha's chapters. The advent of

the "chapter dashboard" and online payment function have also had a profound impact on chapters paying all fees and assessments in a timely fashion. Pi Kappa Alpha's advanced billing structure approved by previous conventions has allowed chapters to more effectively budget and allocate financial resources, improving their standing not just with the International Fraternity, but among their competition at their local institutions as well. Sound financial practices continue to provide the backbone for a chapter's long term success.

## Recruitment

2007-2008 has been yet another landmark year for Pi Kappa Alpha recruitment. With 5,797 pledges and 4,781 initiations, the Fraternity exceeded its goal of 5% quality growth. By focusing on recruiting the "most, best men," Pi Kappa Alpha reasserted itself as the premier college fraternity in all of North America. Thanks to our time-tested recruitment techniques, top-notch recruitment education, and – most importantly – the hard work and dedication of our undergraduate chapters, Pi Kappa Alpha can once again enjoy its view from the top of the fraternity world, boasting the largest average chapter size of any college fraternity with an average size of 65 men.

As another component of the Fraternity's quality growth initiative, Pi Kappa Alpha continues to raise the bar in terms of fraternity expansion. Six new colonies were established and five new chapters installed throughout the academic year. Pi Kappa Alpha anticipates supporting at least eight colonization efforts in 2008-2009 including the University of Arizona (Gamma Delta), Stetson University (Delta Upsilon), Virginia Commonwealth University, University of North Carolina-Pembroke (Eta Omega), McNeese State University, University of North Carolina-Wilmington, Trinity University of San Antonio, and Emory University (Beta Kappa).

## Real Estate

In one form or another, "housing" has been a significant part of the social, college, fraternity experience, on most campuses, since the late 1800's. Where Pi Kappa Alpha is represented, some form of identifiable Greek housing is a relevant issue on 78% of those campuses. The services and programs of the Fraternity's real estate department are all focused on assisting chapters and house corporations at accomplishing these two primary objectives:

- I. Achieving competitive housing; and,
- II. Managing that housing in a manner that grows equity while enhancing the organization's image in the community

A number of metrics have been established to gauge progress within these two main areas; one of those is a grading system that measures the competitive standing of the Pike housing stock. Each facility is judged in three main categories:

1. Location
2. Viability in the Student Housing Market
3. Curb Appeal

Various factors are considered within each category and more weight is placed upon issues believed to be more important or more difficult to change. Although the final 2008 statistics are still being gathered, we have seen a steady increase in the overall grades in the last couple of years. This overall GPA also includes campuses where Pike does not have a house, where housing is a competitive factor, in which case the location would receive an "F" grade or 0.0. Last year the overall grade went from 2.54 to 2.66 (on a 4.0 scale). The "same store" analysis is graded at a 2.65 GPA, which was also an improvement over the previous year.

The Fraternity's real estate loan fund, commonly known as the Chapter House Fund, was established at the 1907 Convention. It is the most tangible program of assistance in the real estate department's tool box to help chapters and house corporations achieve the two primary objectives. A variety of lending programs are available to qualifying groups. The limit for the maximum real estate loan was increased this year to \$400,000. The interest rate formula for the Life Safety Loan Program was also improved to make these loans more affordable. This CHF now resides with White Horse Holding Corporation, also known as White Horse Capital, Inc. It continues to be the most valuable source of capital for groups that have maximized their attainable financing at the local level, yet need additional funding to achieve their real estate endeavors. There is a series of three articles about the 100th anniversary of the Chapter House Fund that have been running in the *Shield & Diamond*; of which the final article appears in this issue.

In the last ten years many additional programs have been developed to augment the lending operations, all with the intent to better assist groups with both the achievement of competitive real estate, and then the effective management thereof.

Following are some notable aspects of the real estate department's major programs:

Lending Operations	\$2,068,260 in new loan funds committed since the last Convention, of which \$731,735 was committed in fiscal year-end June 30, 2008.
Educational Support	Funds ½ the cost of the Volunteer Forum
Life Safety Programs	Loans, grants, and educational materials
Real Estate Incentives	Over \$30,000 in awards and grants annually, all encouraging good real estate management practices
Capital Campaign Assistance	Over \$11.9 million in donor commitments achieved in the last nine years at the local level
Group Property Insurance Program	Comprehensive package of coverages at a low price, available to house corporations
Pike House E-Mail Link	Monthly electronic newsletter providing timely announcements and innovated information related to fraternity housing issues
Property Management	Support information related to outsourcing the property management duties to local professionals
International Work Day	One of the most participated programs in ΠΚΑ with over \$2 million in improvements achieved over the last 10 years.
Various Support Services	Specialized advice and programming to help house corporations and chapters better manage their entity, membership, and real estate

## Alumni and Volunteer Services
